

With more than 12,000 patrons using Footscray Station daily, the footbridge has been designed to create an attractive landmark structure that will improve pedestrian flow. Its strong features draw on the industrial heritage of the area and add to character of the Station precinct.

The (re)Visioning Footscray study identified the values of the Footscray community and helped designers gain a better understanding of what the community wants to see in their future Footscray.

This vital feedback identified important environmental and social issues. The designs complement what is already great about Footscray and are **consistent with community views** which see Footscray as a safe, dynamic and diverse place.

THE DESIGN INCLUDES:

- > A new architect designed footbridge with canopy and lifts for easy access to platforms
- > An open public space between the Station and Irving Street
- > Bicycle facilities, including stair channels
- > Provision for future residential, retail and commercial development.
